## II. <u>Project Updates</u>

#### <u>SCDOT</u>

- I-77 Panther Interchange in York County In procurement, currently evaluating SOQs, announcing short-listed teams on 9/23/20, RFP for IR to be issues on 9/24/20.
- Carolina Crossroads Phase 1 In procurement, currently evaluating Preliminary ATCs, Bid Opening 3/8/21.
- Carolina Crossroads Phase 2 In procurement, currently evaluating SOQs, announcement of short-listed teams on 9/28/20, RFP for IR to be issues on 10/2/20.
- Closed and Load Restricted Bridges 2021-1 –District 4 with 9 bridges. In project development. RFQ in 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2021.
  - Two-phase procurement is anticipated
- Cross Island Parkway Toll Conversion Toll plaza removal, pavement strengthening, limited bridge rehab. Awaiting formal concurrence on delivery method and initiating project development in house. RFQ 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2021.
  - $\circ \quad \text{In House Prep work is anticipated}$
  - Estimating \$15-\$20 Million
  - Fixed price and/or variable scope are on the table
- I-20 over Wateree, River and Overflow Bridges Initiating on-call task order to evaluate rehab versus replacement. RFQ in 2021 or 2022 depending on project type.







- Carolina Crossroads Phase 3 RFQ in 2022
- Mark Clark Expressway Continuing development of Supplemental EIS. RFQ in 2023
- I-26/I-95 Interchange Improvements Awaiting PE funding, possibly in place late spring/early summer 2021
- Low Country Corridor West and I-26/I-526 Interchange ROD is expected in 2022 and RFQ could move to 2027.
  - Phases are being evaluated for procurement type
- Low Country Corridor East Currently in project development and NEPA. Procurement timeframe TBD.
- III. Action Items from 09-16-20
  - A. SCDOT to incorporate check writing comments into the ROW Acquisition Language.
    Still in progress
  - B. SCDOT to revise the entire ROW section in the agreement. (OPEN)  $_{\odot}$   $\,$  Still in progress
  - C. SCDOT to continue to review comments on Design Optimization language in RFP. (OPEN)
    o Language adjustment is still being reviewed.
  - D. SCDOT to schedule an independent meeting with AGC to discuss field overhead rates.
    - Language is going into current proposals with addenda, and includes specific language on overhead, and will specify changes that are allowed, for both time or non-time related.
    - No additional concerns have been raised.
    - Clay and Chris to follow up with Dave.(CLOSED)
  - E. SCDOT to review "Recommended Changes to SCDOT Weather Spec" and discuss and next meeting with Bruce Wells present.
    - Construction is reviewing this Spec
    - Paradigm shift in reviews of weather time
    - Proposed language discussed adds weather calendars that reflect temp restrictions and rainfall events
    - Currently discussing what language will determine what a weather day is
    - Decision has not been made, but discussion is around using NOAA weather data in the calendar(CLOSED)
    - Average temp. data is concerning considering rising temperatures over recent years, source should still be NOAA
    - Weather restrictions can be volatile, could make asphalt the critical path item. 10 days on asphalt could delay the project 6 months.
    - Possibility to make weather charts official for each region of SC
    - Consistency of data is still a concern.
    - Resolution will be considered in a spec update
  - F. SCDOT to internally discuss DBE findings and report back to Subcommittee a position. (OPEN)
    - DBE office has received all relevant documents, SCDOT will report back when DBE has

reviewed the findings.

IV. <u>Revisions to the Preliminary ATC Form</u>

 Requested Preliminary ATC Form to provide flexibility and space for justification and benefits

- 2 pages, 1 attachment
- Restructuring of sections to remove white space on the form
- Teams are running out of room to justify their ATCs
- Each box is requested to be expandable
- SCDOT is not opposed to this request, will discuss internally
- V. <u>Evaluation of Procurement Time from ATC Determination to Cost Proposal Due</u> <u>ACEC</u>
  - 6 weeks is not adequate time between ATC approval and technical proposal submittal, requesting 8 weeks.
  - Compression of time between interview and bid opening is suggested
  - 2 extra weeks will make cost proposal more accurate, so time lost for cost development will be a fair trade off.
  - Also requesting more flexibility around holidays
  - Complexity of specific procurements is more of a concern than simultaneous procurements.
  - ATCs may affect design, especially in interchange type changes. Final determination may change design, and 8 weeks would make it easier on the teams.
  - SCDOT will discuss internally, is interested in getting best technical proposals possible within a reasonable time.

## VI. Insurance and Bonding Review

- SCDOT had a review of Insurance and Bonding language on all contracts
- Have developed new section (section 6) for DB agreement to clarify intent
- Format change, requires same forms, but some new information has been added
- Includes: Pollution liability, professional liability, aircraft liability, railroad protective liability
- General Provisions have been added, expands on original language
- Bonding provision is essentially the same as before.
- Will be dispersed to AGC/ACEC for review, timeframe to be determined.
