Instructional Bulletin 2001-8, Pavement Design Coordination

When identifying pavement structure on the Typical Section Sheet in a set of right of way and construction plans, include the specified type of mix that is noted in the Pavement Design. This information needs to be on the Typical Section Sheet before submitting to the Pavement Design Engineer for approval.

If the mix is changed during the development of a project, please insure that the Typical Section Sheets are also revised to reflect the change. All revised Typical Section Sheets needing Pavement Design Engineer approval must be resubmitted to the Pavement Design Engineer. In all case, especially when a pavement design is not obtained from the Pavement Design Engineer, be sure the selected pavements are in compliance with Instructional Bulletin No. 2001-1, Guidelines for Hot Mix Asphalt Selection.
