Certain pay items in a contract may require a contractor to perform work but specific instructions or details are not shown in the plans. Generally, these items are requested by the District on the Design Field Review or are procedural on each project. The following list of pay items are to be entered into the Trns*port module PES by the designer responsible for the plan quantities; however, these items are not to be listed on the Estimated Quantity Sheet in the plans.
