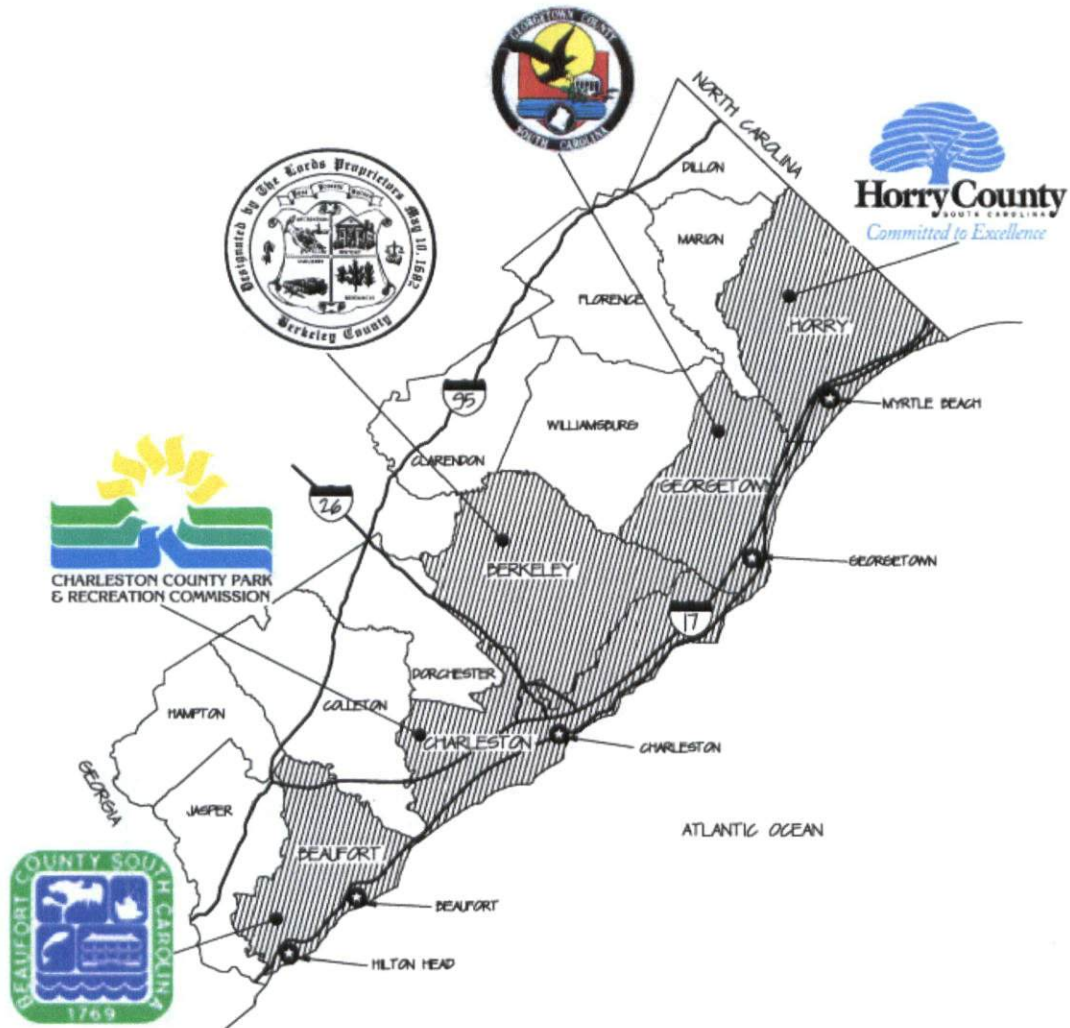


# South Carolina Coastal Boat Ramp Study

**SITE NAME & ATLAS NO.:** *Yauhannah – 26001*

**WATERWAY:** *Great Pee Dee River*

**I. SITE NARRATIVE**

Yauhannah is a frequently used landing by both in-county and out-of-county residents. The site is located within the Pee Dee flood plain under the 701 bridge. The site is accessed by two steep, narrow roads ending in a stone and mud parking area. There is a new dual lane concrete ramp with a recently paved parking area. There is also a floating dock.

LISTED IN ORDER OF PRIORITY FIRST TO LAST**

1. *County Sheriffs office and SCDNR Game Wardens should visit site. Site has an image of vandalism.*
2. *Access/Egress onto Highway 701 is awkward and possibly unsafe. When 701 bridges are rebuilt, access and egress should be studied and possibly modified.*
3. *Put signs on US 701-Caution...boats/trailers entering highway.*
4. *Expand parking if land can be made available.*
5. *Monitor floating dock to see if it is working properly (listing on one side is apparent)*

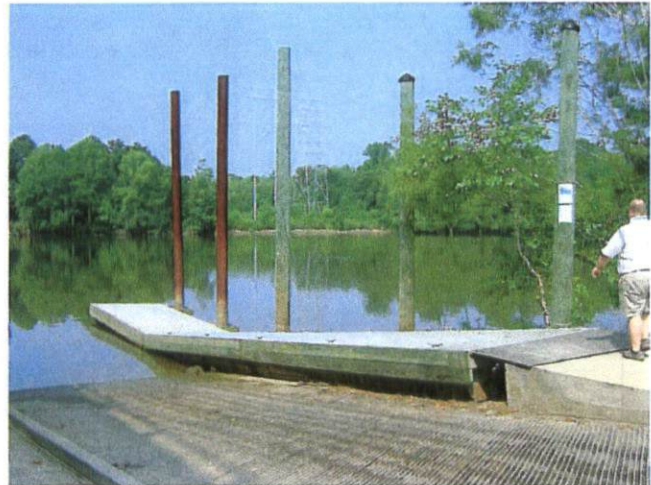
