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Introduction

AASHTOWare Project™ (*AWP*) is a web-based program consisting of several modules designed to electronically allow the SCDOT to manage the entire lifecycle of construction contracts using a standardized format while providing a collaborative environment.

AASHTOWare Project Construction and Materials[™] (*PrCM*) is a module designed to support the complete construction and materials management process.

Navigating the System

Home Screen

When you login to AASHTOWare Project, you will be taken to the **Home** Screen.




Figure 1 - Home Screen

Home Button

The Home Button will return you to the Home Screen from anywhere in the system.

Role Selector

The Role Selector is used to set the active role.

Previous Button

The Previous Button is used to navigate back one screen.

NOTE: It is recommended to not use the browser's back button.



Previous Selector

The Previous Selector lets you choose from your last previously viewed 10 screens.




Figure 6 - Previous Selector

My Pages Button:

The My Pages Button navigates to a list of your favorite screens.

My Pages Selector:

The My Pages Selector provides a drop down list for your favorite screens. You can also add a favorite by selecting "Remember this Page".

Global Actions Selector

The Global Actions Selector provides a drop down list for generating reports, running processes, and the system email.




Figure 9 - Global Actions Selector

Global Help Button

The Global Help Button opens a help screen in a separate browser window.

Log off Button

The Log off Button is used to log out of AASHTOWare Project.

Component Quick Links

Component Quick Links are located on each component and take you to associated components for quick access.

Role Description

The Role Description displays the active role being used.

Components

Components are sections within the system and have a blue header bar. Your role determines which components are visible and accessible.

Component Row Action Menu

The Component Row Action Menu displays a drop down list of available actions for a component.

Component Minimize/Maximize Button

The Component Minimize/Maximize Button can be used to hide or unhide component content.

Row Action Menu

The Row Action Menu displays a drop down list of available actions for the selected row.




Figure 18 - Role Action Menu



Searching

Search Boxes

Search Boxes are located throughout the system. To start a search, type in the appropriate search criteria and press ENTER. **If you need to clear the search criteria, click the eraser icon** located to the right of the search criteria.

Sorting and Filtering

Sort and Filter options are located to the right of each search box. If there are no options currently available, there will be an "Advanced" link. In many instances, there will be pre-made and system default filters available.

- System Default no filter used
- Custom filters created by the user or the system administrator
- Advanced used to create a custom filter (temporary or permanent)
- Temporary custom filter used once

Advanced Filters

Filters can be used as a powerful query tool and a method to sort the displayed data. Multiple filters can be setup to narrow down your search. These filters can be temporary, saved, or set as the default for the user.




Figure 21 - Advanced Filters (Example)



Range Fill

Range Fill can be used to fill a list of records with the same information. This makes tedious data entry easier. Where available, click the range fill button and select the option that fits your needs.




Figure 22 - Range Fill

Saving a Record

Before saving a record, all required fields must be populated with data. If a red asterisk is located beside a field, it is identifying that record as a required field.




Figure 23 – Required Fields

Save Buttons are typically located on the Component Header. Clicking the button allows you to save the record.




Figure 24 - Save Button

Messages (Save)

Message boxes can appear before or after saving a record. If you see a red message box, you must correct the error before you are allowed to save the record.




Figure 25 - Save Error Message



A green message box will indicate that the record saved.

A yellow message box is just a warning.

Note: You can still see warning messages on saved records

Deleting a Record

If a saved record needs to be deleted, this is typically accomplished by selecting "Delete" located in the Row Action Menu.

When a record is marked for deletion, you will see an Undo Button. This button allows you to cancel your deletion before saving.




Figure 30 - Undo

To proceed with a deletion, press Save.

Field Magnifiers

Field Magnifiers are located in text boxes throughout the system. They provide an easier viewing experience when you have to enter or read large amounts of text.

Click the Field Magnifier located to the left of the text box

Enter your text and click Apply




Figure 30 - Apply Magnifier
