INSTRUCTIONAL BULLETIN NO. 2007-2

SUBJECT: Implementation of Changes to Low Side Paved Shoulders in Superelevation

EFFECTIVE DATE: January 24, 2007

SUPERSEDES: None

RE: Highway Design Manual revisions dated November 2006 Chapter 11

Superelevation for earth shoulders are not affected by the revisions referenced above. Projects being developed that will not be submitted to Right of Way by March 30, 2007, will have the superelevation of the paved shoulders revised in accordance with the new revisions to the Highway Design Manual dated November 2006.

Projects that do not involve obtaining new right of way and are to be let after May, 2007 will revise the superelevation of the paved shoulders in accordance with the new revisions to the Highway Design Manual dated November 2006.

Projects that have paved shoulders and have gone to Right of Way prior to February 28, 2007, but construction obligation is over two years away (February 2009) should have their superelevation reviewed. This review should be by the Project Development Team and determined, on a project by project basis, if these superelevation changes should be implemented.
