SUBJECT: Prime Coat

EFFECTIVE DATE: April 8, 1994

SUPERSEDES: New

RE: None

Beginning with the August 1994 highway letting, prime will be required to be calculated and added to the list of estimated quantities for projects using Graded Aggregate Base Courses and Sand Clay Base Course. The rate will be 0.27 gallon per square yard (1.2 liters per square meter for metric plans). When computing square area, include the entire width of the base courses.

The pay item will be "Prime Coat" computed in gallons (liters) and the BAMS number is 4010005.

Since most plans that are currently being worked probably will not be let before the August 1994 highway letting, you should begin following this procedure immediately.
