The alternate pipe notes (copy attached) used on the "General Construction Note" Sheet when alternate pipe is specified on federal aid project plans has been revised to read as shown below:

ALTERNATE PIPE SELECTION NOTE:

WHEN CORRUGATED ALUMINUM ALLOY PIPE IS SELECTED FOR USE, THE DIAMETERS WILL BE ONE STANDARD PIPE SIZE LARGER THAN REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE.

ALTERNATE PIPE FOR SIDELINES MUST HAVE EACH END BEVELED TO MATCH THE ADJACENT SLOPES. NO SEPARATE PAYMENT WILL BE MADE FOR PROVIDING THESE BEVELED ENDS.

The notes have been made into a cell (actual cell shown on attached sheet) and can be retrieved from the metric or english cell library using the cell name, APIPE.


