SUBJECT: Bridge End Curb and Flume - Updated

The Bridge End Curb and Flume has been revised as per Special Drawings std721br and m721ar. When an approach slab (Alternate 2) is constructed, 13 L.F. of Concrete Curb (9" x 15") shall be added to the General Construction Note to be used as directed by the Engineer. Typically, when there is an approach slab, 9" x 15" Concrete Curb will not be necessary. The inclusion of 9" x 15" Concrete Curb, even though not usually needed with approach slabs, will be provided to address any unusual site conditions. The curb from the bridge end to the flume is included in the concrete approach slab found in the bridge plans.
