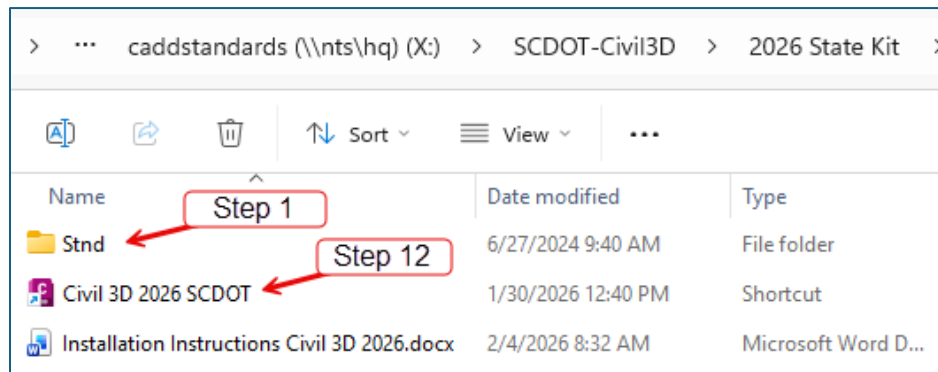


Civil 3D 2026 Installation

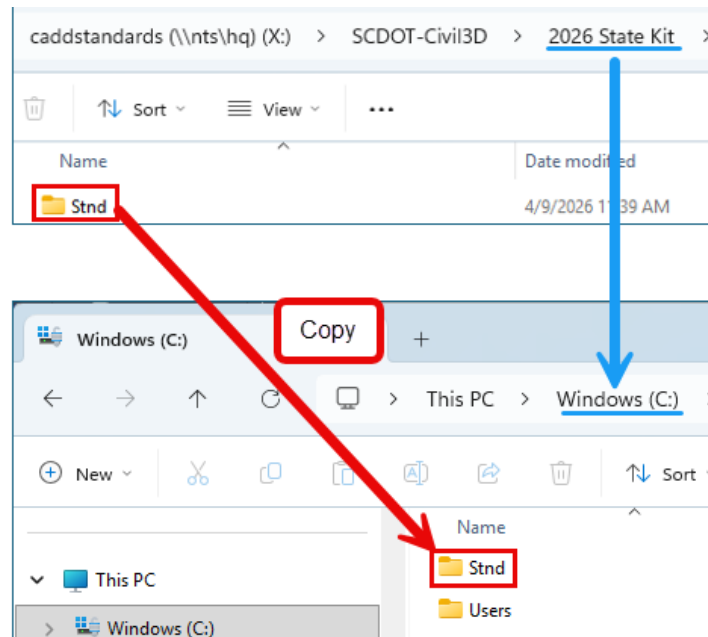
Follow these installation instructions in the order presented

Unzip the 2026 State Kit folder

The folder should contain the items in the image below. The items will need to be copied from this folder to your local computer to complete the setup for Civil 3D.



1. Open a second file explorer window and copy the folder "Stnd" directly to your computers "C:\\" drive.

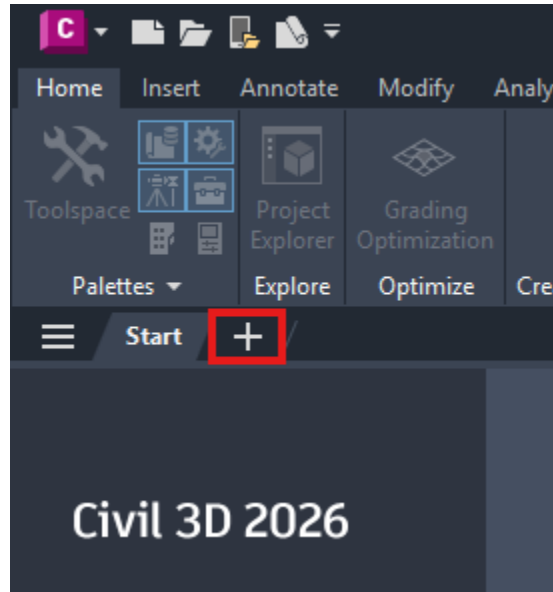


- a. If a "Stnd" folder already exists on the "C:\\" drive, delete it before copying over the newer version.

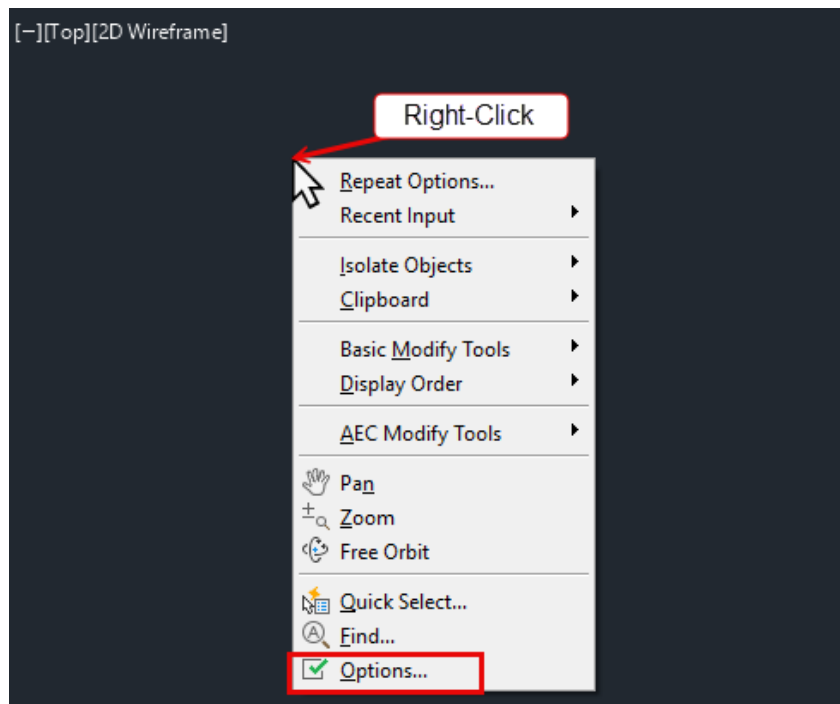
2. After placing the “Stnd” folder open the Civil 3D 2026 Imperial icon on your desktop.



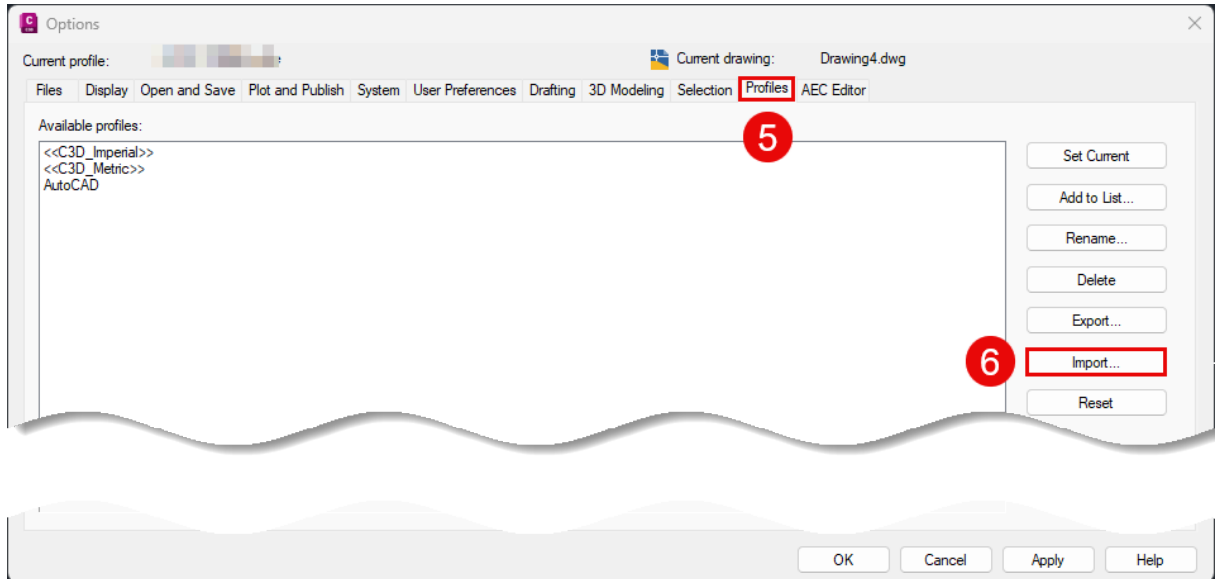
3. If a drawing does not open automatically select the “+” in the upper left corner



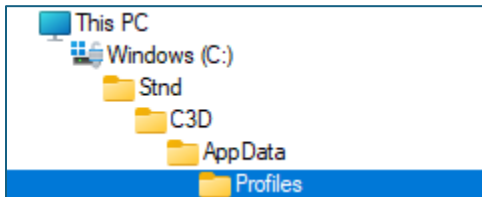
4. Once there is an open drawing, right-click in the drawing area and select “Options”



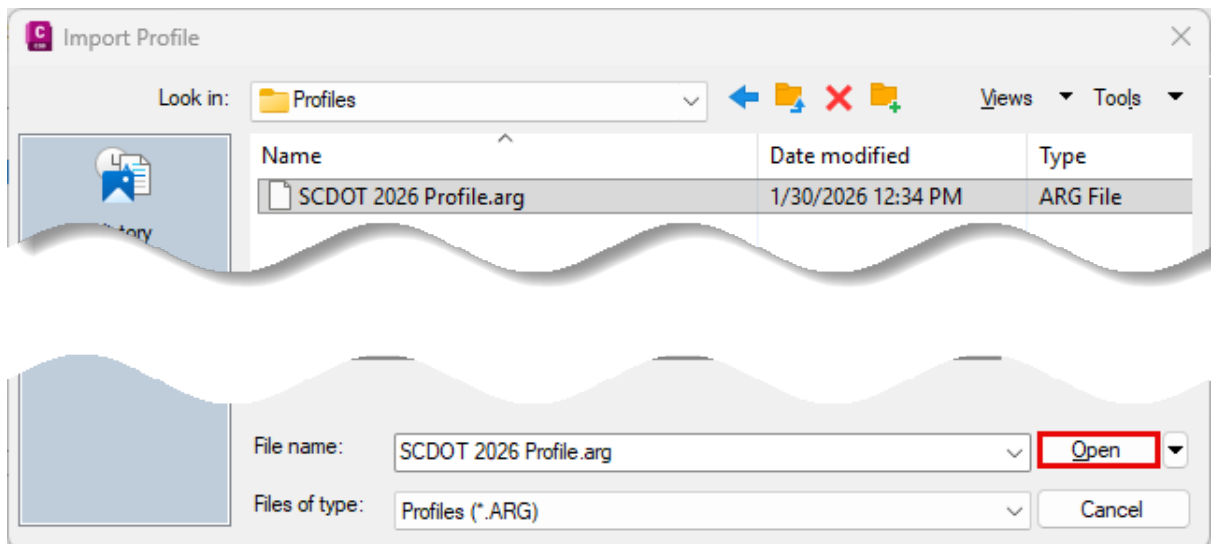
5. Switch to the Profiles tab within the Options dialog.
6. Select Import... on the right side



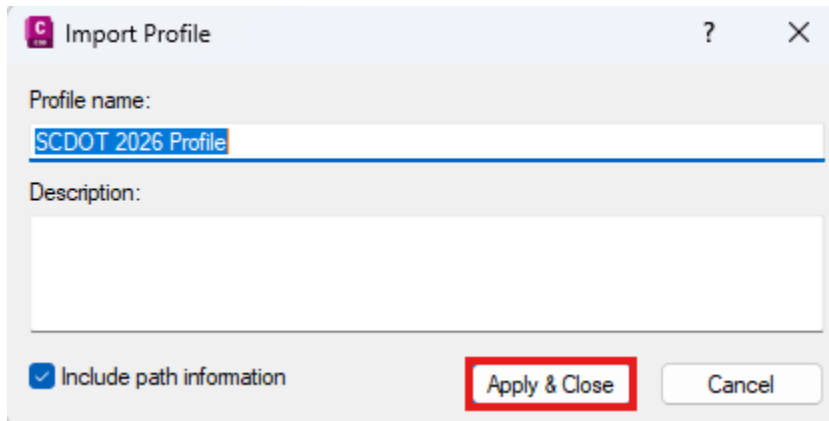
7. Navigate to the filepath listed below and select the "SCDOT 2026 Profile.arg" file
<C:\Std\C3D\AppData\Profiles>



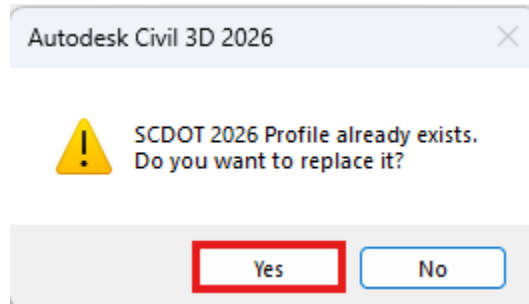
8. Select Open to import the profile.



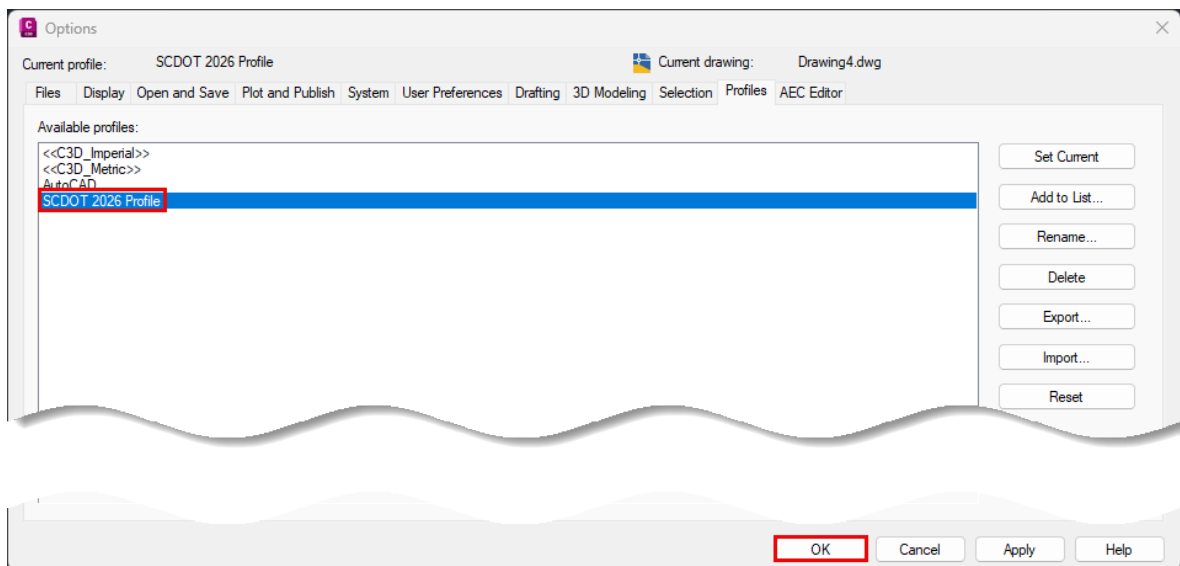
9. Select Apply & Close. *DO NOT CHANGE THE PROFILE NAME*, you can provide a description if you would like.



- a. If the profile already exists and this dialog appears, select Yes.

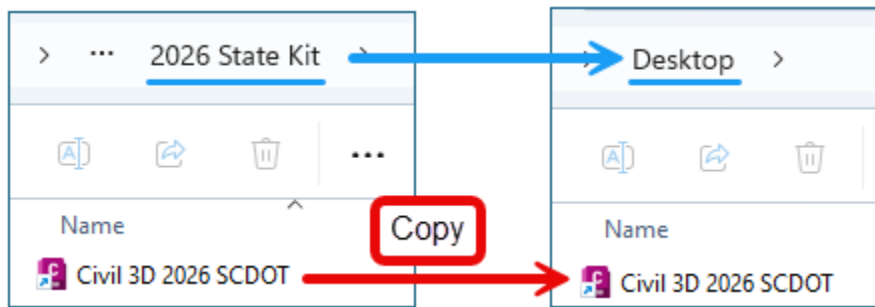


10. Select "OK" to close the Options Dialog.

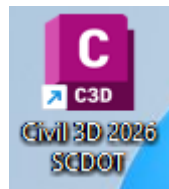


11. Close out of the Civil 3D program.

12. Next copy the “Civil 3D 2026 SCDOT” shortcut from the to your desktop.



13. Relaunch Civil 3D using the “Civil 3D 2026 SCDOT” shortcut that was just copied onto your desktop.



- a. Additionally, after launching Civil 3D you can pin the shortcut to the taskbar, and Civil 3D can thereafter be launched from the taskbar rather than the desktop if desired.
