S-57 (Old River Road) over Barfield Old Mill Creek experienced a bridge collapse during the 2015 flood event. The existing bridge (pre-flood) was approximately 28 feet wide by 42 feet in length. The replacement bridge will be constructed with the following commitments: The pre-existing bridge will be replaced with a bridge on existing location.

Comments							
The project corridor was surveyed for cultural resources on November 6, 2015. The dimensions of the survey corridor were approximately 600' north of the bridge and 500' to the south (100' to each side of centerline). A low density prehistoric ceramic/lithic scatter was identified within the northeast quadrant of the survey corridor on an elevated landform that directly overlooks Barfield's Old Mill Creek. The majority of the artifacts were recovered from the Ap Horizon. Although no diagnostic artifacts were recovered the sand tempered ceramics from the site can generally be assigned to the Woodland Period (500 B.C 800 AD). The site is a relatively common example of a small hunter gatherer occupation located near the interface of an upland landform and a riparian environment. It is possible that the site extended further to the west but was impacted by the construction of S-57. The site exhibits little research potential beyond recordation and has been determined not eligible for the listing in the National Register. The remainder of the corridor was shovel tested (in high prob areas) but no artifacts were recovered.
