Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The purpose of the project is to improve pedestrian safety along Sol Legare Road by providing a dedicated sidewalk where none currently exists along the roadway. Sol Legare residents have requested safety improvements for pedestrians for many years. In the last 5 years, there have been approximately 50 reported accidents on Soi Legare Road including one pedestrian fatality in 2022. The community has reported several other pedestrian injury and fatal accidents dating before the available SCDPS records which only recorded accidents back to 2018. A dedicated pedestrian facility woull provide a significant benefit to the community and provide a connection to transit.
