

Accounting of how these funds will be spent.

Lights will be installed along the on and off ramps at Exit 38 on Interstate 95. Currently there are no lights at the interchange. This is the only interchange in Hampton County. There are two industrial parks in close proximity to the Interstate exchange as well as the Town of Yemassee. These lights will better serve those vehicles, especially large eighteen-wheel trucks, entering and exiting the interstate. The lights will improve safety on the off and on ramps and as well as the approach to the off and on ramps.

Dominion Energy has agreed to design and install the lights for approximately \$400,000. Hampton County intends to partner with the Town of Yemassee for the ongoing operating costs of the lights. The requested funds will be spent on the design and installation of the lights along the approach to and the on/off ramps at Exit 38.

These funds will be used to provide a public benefit.

The enhanced safety will be a public benefit. Additionally, the nearby industrial parks will be able to better attract prospects for investment into Hampton County due to the lighting improvements at Exit 38. And finally, the Town of Yemassee will also benefit from being able to attract visitors off of the interstate to the Town businesses.

Scope of Services.

Hampton County will utilize the funds to make improvements at Exit 38. Specifically, the scope of work includes the design and installation of lights along the approach to and the off/on ramps at Exit 38. Use of these funds will be limited to installation. Operating costs are expected to be covered by a partnership between Hampton County and the Town of Yemassee.

Timeline/Schedule for completion

The anticipated timeline is to complete the project prior to the end of the fiscal year, June 30th, 2024.
