PROJECT OVERVIEW

South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) proposes to widen US Route 17 (Speedway Blvd.) beginning at the Georgia state line and ending at SC Route 170. The purpose of this project is to improve safety and increase capacity along US Route 17. The project is funded through preliminary engineering and right-of-way by the Lowcountry Council of Governments. The majority of the project as proposed will be constructed within the SCDOT existing right-of-way. The project is currently not funded for construction.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

The purpose of the meeting is to allow the local community, concerned citizens and project stakeholders an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed widening of US Route 17 (Speedway Blvd.). This meeting is being conducted with an informal, open house format. You are encouraged to review the various displays and discuss your questions or concerns with any of the SCDOT representatives at this meeting. You are also encouraged to provide written comments on the forms provided so that we may have a written record of your concerns or suggestions. PROPOSED PROJECT INFORMATION

US Route 17 is currently a two-lane ditch typical section. The Department is proposing to widen US Route 17 to a four lane roadway with a divided median. Existing SCDOT right-of-way varies from 200 to 300 feet wide. This roadway currently has an average daily traffic (ADT) of 14,700 vehicles per day with a level of service rating of C in 2009. If no improvements are made, future projections show a 2033 level of service F with an ADT of 21,900 vehicles per day. The construction of a 4 lane divided section would improve the 2033 level of service to a B.

The Department is currently reviewing various alternatives including a narrower median, or shifting the alignment to reduce right of way and wetland impacts between the S.C.L. railroad bridge and the intersection of US Route 17 and SC Route 170, adjacent to the National Wildlife Refuge.

PROJECT STATUS AND PATH FORWARD

SCDOT is currently performing environmental studies and preliminary design on the proposed widening project. The information gathered from the various studies, along with your input will be used to assist with selecting a Preferred Alternative. Once selected, the Preferred Alternative will be presented at an official Public Hearing, at which time the public will have a second opportunity to ask questions and provide input on the project.

RE: Proposed Widening of US Route 17 (Speedway Blvd.)

I received the informational material for your recent public meeting regarding the widening of US 17 from the Georgia state line to SC Route 170. I and my staff were unable to attend, but I would like to share our comments via this letter.

The project information sheet shows a proposed typical section with shoulders two feet wide on each side of the divided highway. While the proposed project addresses the future volume of motorized vehicles projected by SCDOT, it has negligible shoulders and no other type of facility to accommodate bicyclists in the corridor.

We are particularly concerned about this lack of bicycle facilities because that segment of US 17 is part of the East Coast Greenway, which will eventually run from Florida to Maine, connecting Savannah, Beaufort, and Charleston along the way (maps enclosed). US 17 is an important segment of the greenway because it is the most direct connection between these popular coastal destinations.

We strongly encourage SCDOT to include a minimum 10-foot wide paved path in the right-of way to one side of the project, separated by several feet of grass or by a barrier. There already exists an example in a newer, divided section of US 17 in South Carolina, near Gardens Corner, where a paved path separated by several feet grass runs along the east side of the roadway.

Also, we hope coordination efforts between SCDOT and GDOT are taking place to ensure economically efficient designs in the long run, as related to timing and scope of projects, and a safe transition of bicycle facilities between SCDOT's proposed US 17 widening and GDOT's Back River Bridge Replacement (PI 522920).

We expect the East Coast Greenway, when at least regionally connected, to bring economic benefits to both Georgia and South Carolina. We appreciate your attention to this opportunity to complete a segment of the greenway in the US 17 widening project.


