

SFY 2019-2020 Spending Plan (Budget) and Estimated Revenues Update

The FY 2020-21 Appropriations Act has not become law, therefore beginning July 1, the state will operate under the Continuing Resolution (Act 135 of 2020) adopted by the General Assembly on May 12th. In accordance with the Continuing Resolution, agency recurring appropriations will continue at the amounts included in the FY 2019-20 Appropriations Act.

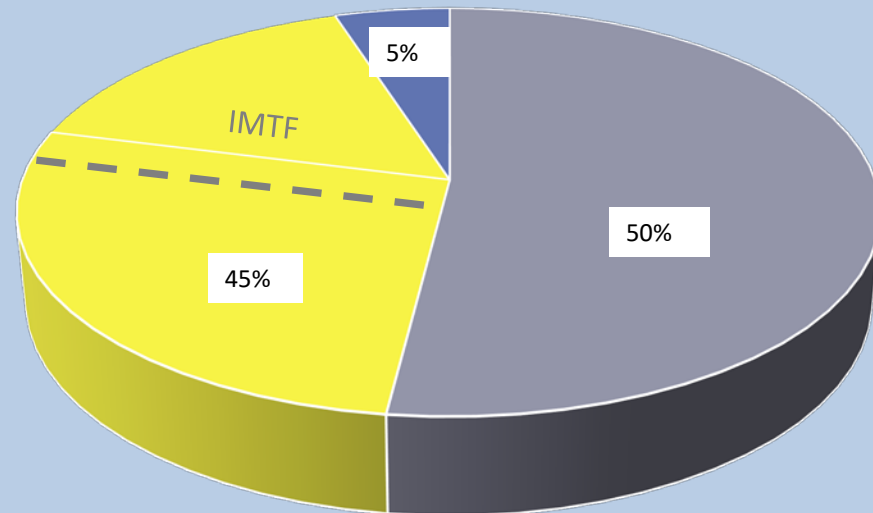
